The permissible upwards error for "Arming Sword" and "one-handed" weapons is 100g.

The permissible upwards error for "Long" weapons is 200g.

The permissible upwards error for "Two-handed" weapons is 300g.

Heavier weapons or thrust weapons are not allowed under any circumstance.

The edge of all blades must be rebated and have a thickness of 2mm or more. This applies to striking and non-striking edges of all weapons.

The Radius of all edges must be more than 10mm.

Only Weapons which have chronological validity of a specific historical period as confirmed by the Authenticity Committee are allowed.
