

#### Marshal Accreditation

#### **Marshal Accreditation**

Marshal Accreditation is the process that our Sport accredits its marshals from a Trainee to an International Marshal. This process will ensure that our regions have a high standard of marshals. The process to become accredited is in 8 stages.

STAGE 1 – LEARNING THE RULES

STAGE 2 - WORK AT EVENTS WITH REGIONAL HEAD MARSHAL

STAGE 3 – TAKE THE REGIONAL MARSHAL ACCREDITATION TEST

STAGE 4 – WORK AT EVENT WITH THE CONFERENCE HEAD MARSHAL

STAGE 5 – TAKE THE CONFERENCE MARSHAL ACCREDITATION TEST

STAGE 6 – INTERVIEW WITH CONFERENCE HEAD MARSHAL

STAGE 7 – BECOMING AN ACCREDITED CONFERENCE MARSHAL

STAGE 8 – INTERNATIONAL MARSHAL ACCREDITATION

If there is no Regional Head Marshal in a Country or Region, the Conference Head Marshal for that country or region will be responsible for the training of Marshals until a Regional Head Marshal is appointed.

To maintain International Marshal Accreditation, Marshals are required to Marshal 2 Events per Calendar year.



#### STAGE 1 – LEARNING THE RULES

Before you can work in the list, Trainee marshals will need to read all the rules from Buhurt International. Below are some ideas to help you.

Download and print all rules and regulations found on the Buhurt International website.

Ask you Regional Head Marshal Questions on rules you are unsure of.

# STAGE 2 – WORK AT EVENTS WITH REGIONAL HEAD MARSHAL

Trainee marshals will be required to work at Three Events or Two Events and an Official Regional Training Event with a Regional Head Marshal. Trainee marshals will be paired with an already Regional Accredited Marshal, Conference Accredited Marshal or International Accredited Marshal to learn from. Trainee marshals are not permitted in the list while fighting is occurring. Below are some ideas to help you.

Talk and ask questions to the Marshal you are paired with.

Talk and ask questions to the Knight Marshal.

Participate in all Marshalling areas of the event. E.g. Weapons check, Armour check, Counting Duels and Buhurt.

# STAGE 3 – TAKE THE REGIONAL MARSHAL ACCREDITATION TEST

After you have worked at the required number of events, you will be able to take the Regional Accreditation Test. The Test is a 10 Question test. The test will cover Buhurt, Duels, Weapon's and basic Authenticity rules. Once you have you Regional Accreditation you will be able to marshal in the list. You will be given a Regional Marshal Certificate.

### STAGE 4 – WORK AT EVENT WITH CONFERENCE HEAD MARSHAL

Regional Marshals will be required to work at an Event with the Conference Head Marshal. Regional Marshals will work on all aspects of Marshalling at this Event. After the Event, the Conference Head Marshal will let you know if you are ready to take the Conference Accreditation Test or if you need to do another Event with them. Below are some ideas to help you.

Talk and ask questions to the Knight Marshal.

Participate in all Marshalling areas of the event. E.g. Weapons check, Armour check, Counting Duels and Buhurt.

### STAGE 5 – TAKE THE CONFERENCE MARSHAL ACCREDITATION TEST

After you have your Regional Accreditation and have completed an event with your Conference Head Marshal, you can take the Conference Marshal Accreditation Test. The Test is a 40 Question test. The test will cover Buhurt, Duels, Weapon's and basic Authenticity rules. Below are some ideas to help you.

Talk and ask questions to the Knight Marshal.

Study all Buhurt International Rules sets.

# STAGE 6 – INTERVIEW WITH CONFERENCE HEAD MARSHAL

Once you have completed your Conference Marshal Accreditation Test, you will have an interview with your Conference Head Marshal. This interview will be to look at questions that you may have gotten wrong or that more information is required. The Conference Head Marshal may ask you further question. Below are some ideas to help you.

Be honest in your answers.

The Conference Head Marshal is there to help you not to fail you.



# STAGE 7 – BECOMING ACCREDITED CONFERENCE MARSHAL

If you have failed your Test, you will continue being a Regional Marshal. You will need to repeat stages 4,5 and 6 again until you receive your accreditation.

If you have passed your Test and Interview, you are now a Conference Accredited Marshal. This means you are allowed to work in the list and can work as either a Lines Marshal, Field Marshal or Knight Marshal. You will be given a Conference Marshal Certificate.

# STAGE 8 – INTERNATIONAL MARSHAL ACCREDDITATION

The International Marshal Accreditation, is the highest level a Marshal can receive. This level of Accreditation is for Buhurt International Events where the level of marshal experience is higher such as Conference Events. This process will ensure that our Buhurt International events have a high standard of marshals.

Before you can attempt the Buhurt International Marshal Accreditation process, you must be Conference Marshal Accredited.

Conference marshals will be required to work at 2 Buhurt International events and have them Video Recorded. These events maybe from the Regional and Conference Marshal Process. These videos must be given to Buhurt International Marshal Committee to review. The Buhurt International Marshal Committee will review these videos to make sure the Marshal is at a particular skill level.

Once the Buhurt International Marshal Committee have reviewed your videos you will have an interview with them. In the interview the committee will go over any questions they have about your videos. The committee may also ask any other questions that they may have.

If you have failed your Interview process you will continue being a Conference Marshal. You will need to repeat the Buhurt International Marshal Accreditation Process until you receive your accreditation.

If you have passed your Interview, you are now an Internationally Accredited Marshal. This means you are allowed to work in Buhurt International events that require this particular Accreditation. You will be given a Buhurt International Marshal Certificate.

To maintain International Marshal Accreditation, Marshals are required at 2 events per season.
